- Wash all the glassware and dry it.
- All ingredients are weight accurately amla, hibiscus powder, orange powder, moringa powder,
- Take all the powders in a beaker with sufficient amount of water and heat the mixture in water bath with continuous stirring till both the powders are miscible.
- Cool the mixture and add the almond oil, aloevera and vitamin E in given mixture continuously.
- Then rest the mixture for 5 min and add rose water in the given mixture.
- Filter the serum and add it to a spray bottle.

EVALUATION OF HERBAL HAIR SERUM

1) APPEARANCE:

- Physical appearance was evaluated by observation.
- It includes the texture, colure, and smell, consistency, are studied of herbal serum.

2) pH TEST:

- The pH test is studied using various buffer solutions
- The tests are performed by using the digital pH meter
- The electrode of digital pH meter was dipped in the herbal hair serum formulation and the pH value is detected.
- It should have the acidic PH because the PH of skin is acidic about the 4-6

3) HOMOGENEITY TEST

- A clean and dry Petri dish was smeared with the hair serum and it covers with the glass seal
- The appearance of herbal hair serum was observed under the light
- Check the homogeneity of particles present in the herbal serum
- Herbal hair serum tested by visual examination for homogeneity and tested for some lumps and flocculates.

4) VISCOSITY

- The viscosity measurement was performed with spindle number 64 on a Brookfield viscometer at 100rpm
- The serum was placed in viscometer for 5-10 min before the measurement

5) STABILITY TEST
